The Sandy Ridge Trail System, less than 20 minutes from Welches, is being expanded and will offer an additional two miles of new trails. At its March 10, 2016, meeting, the Clackamas County Board of Commissioners approved the sale of 188 acres to the Bureau of Land Management and BLM will begin adding up to two miles of new trails to the system as well as significantly increasing the parking capabilities. Bring your mountain bike and the rest is FREE!

Such is the location of Whispering Woods Resort that you can "do" whatever interests you. For example, the City of Portland is about an hour away, a 27-hole golf course adjoins the property, live entertainment is offered within minutes of the resort, outstanding restaurants serving everything from burgers to some of the finest gourmet meals are abundant and can be reached quickly (two are within walking distance), Mt. Hood Adventure Park at Ski Bowl is 15 minutes away, historic Timberline Lodge is less than a 30-minute drive and offers year-round skiing, Columbia Gorge wine country is a little more than an hour away...you get the idea, right? NO SMOKING POLICY

All units at Whispering Woods are non-smoking units. Smoking is not allowed within 10 feet of any door or window, making the decks and patios non-smoking areas. For those who do want to smoke, we are building several small shelters around the property. The first shelter has been completed and is located at Whispering Woods II, between Buildings A and B.

To eliminate any confusion about what is and is not considered "smoking," the No Smoking policy includes e-cigarettes and other vaping devices, as well as marijuana.
